

INTRODUCTION:

This book is a memorial to those who have come before us. Our ancestors have laid the path before our feet, they struggled to ease our way and they are the foundation of our appearance and identity. It is our duty to keep the knowledge and records of our fathers and mothers and to pass them on to future generations.

This work establishes all sixteen of Alvia's great great grandparents and vindicates the lineages with records. The book is split into four volumes. His wife, Mary Tobin, was the daughter of Irish immigrants and her family is also a subject of the first volume. The whole book is divided into sixteen sections (each volume does not contain the same number of sections, they were divide based on page count for ease of binding). Every two sections pertain to one family tree. The first section of each pair consists of the following: a 5-generation tree that lists the ancestors in a family tree format and an individuals-list that contains vital facts and other information. The second section in each pair contains actual copies of the records and sources that correlate to the individual facts. To view the records that vindicate the individual facts, match the subscripted number at the end of an individual's life event fact to the corresponding record/source that has a number before its title. An example of this is below.

Example:



Some of the individual facts have multiple sources and therefore correspond to multiple records/sources. All individuals have birth (b.) and marriage (m.) facts accompanied by who they married and who their parents were (if known). In the case of unknown spouses and/or parents, question marks are in place. Question marks are also used if a surname is listed with no known given name and vice-versa. Many (but not all) show death (d.), occupation/military & signatures, known children & profile photos. Facts subscripted with a zero are based on information from family members a.k.a. oral history.

Any parents named with a * next to their name represents an assumed line without any published source to verify the link. These assumptions are made using logical deduction such as, a woman's maiden name is found, but no sources name her parents, the town only has that one family in it and all the parents' children are in the appropriate age group of the woman in question, situations like these provide "most likely" parental matches for the lineages in some instances.

A few individuals have a{#} marker after their name. This signifies that they have more than one child in the lineage of Alvia Leon Keyser II. A.K.A., repeat ancestors.

Mr. Keyser was in the construction business all his life and owned and operated his own business, Leon Keyser, Inc., out of Manchester, N.H., for several years. He then was a field supervisor for Cote Construction Company in Van Buren from 1953 to 1970.

He was a member of the Maine Society of the Sons of the American Revolution, the New Hampshire Society of Genealogists, the Maine Genealogical Society, the New Hampshire Historical Society and the Oregon-California Trails Association.

Surviving are a son, Richard K. of Auburn; seven grandchildren and 16 great-grandchildren.
