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York, and The Republican of New York City. He holds honorary membership in many societies throughout the state for the conservation of natural resources, and is a member of the American Forestry Association. His public speaking and his office of commissioner of forests has gained Mr. Whipple a wide circle of friends and acquaintances, and has made him one of the best known men in the state. He married, November 25, 1873, Sarah R. Dean, born July 10, 1851, daughter of Seymour and Margaret (Evarts) Dean. Children: 1. Gertrude A., born September 5, 1874; married Olga McGuire. He served as a private in the Seventy-first New York during the Spanish-American war. Was for several years connected with the business affairs of the Bell Telephone Company in New York City, and is now connected with the *Knickerbocker Express*, a daily paper published in Albany. New York. 2. Gertrude D., born April 5, 1876; a lawyer now in practice in Salamanca; married Laura S. Vreeland; children, James Vreeland and Elizabeth Olive. 3. Willis Walton, born February 16, 1882; prepared for the profession of dentistry at Michigan University, class of 1906, and at the New York School of Dentistry. He is now engaged in the practice of his profession in Salamanca. He married, October 7, 1908, Wilhelmina Edith Sander, child, Vivian Olive, born February 15, 1910.

This family is traced through its varied spellings: Peaselee, Peaseley, Peasele, Pease, Pease, Peaseley, Peasey, Peasele, Peaseley (Irish) and Peasley (Scottish). These variations are more numerous in the first and second generations, while the majority of the present generation spell the name Peasele.

The American family was founded in Massachusetts about 1635 and from there has spread to every state and territory in the Union. Many distinguished men have borne the name or inherited the blood through intermarriage. One of the latter is John Greenleaf Whittier, the poet. Two governors of New Hampshire have borne the name, a chief justice of the Massachusetts supreme court and several members of congress. Few men have attained higher honor in the medical profession than Dr. Edmund Randolph Peasele, of New York City, while judges, clergymen, lawyers, physicians, educators, eminent business men and farmers

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although a special fine of five shillings was to be imposed on them for each offense. In 1658 the general court ordered Joseph Peasele and Thomas Macy to appear before the next term of said court to answer for their disobedience. This mandate was also unheeded, and Joseph Peasele continued to preach, with the result that he was fined five shillings per week. While there is no evidence to show that Joseph Peasele joined the Society of Friends, his friend, Thomas Macy, was prosecuted and fined for allowing four of that sect to take shelter in his house one rainy day for three-quarters of an hour. There was no society of "Friends" organized in New England prior to his death, the early comers being cruelly persecuted and sent back to England. Joseph was opposed to the Puritan church in his religious convictions, hence his disregard of the orders from the court to conform to the state church. He died December 5, 1666, leaving his wife, Mary, executrix of his estate that was appraised at three hundred and sixty-four pounds. In 1662 she was granted one hundred and eight acres of land in Salisbury. She died in Haverhill in 1694.

Children: 1. Jane, married, December 10, 1646, John Davis, and settled at Oyster river, New Hampshire (now Durham). 2. Mary, married a lawyer, Joseph Whittier, and lived ever having married. 4. Sarah, married Thomas Barnard (2), April 12, 1664; lived at Amesbury. 5. Joseph, of further mention.

(II) Dr. Joseph (2) Peasele, only son and youngest child of Joseph (1) and Mary (John-son) Peasele, was born at Haverhill, Massachusetts, September 9, 1646, died there March 21, 1734. Prior to his father's death in 1660 he was granted "Children's Land" and October 10, 1666, a "township," the latter a term used to indicate prospective rights. About 1673 he built his house in East Haverhill near "Rocks Bridge," spanning the Merrimac, using bricks brought from England. It was of two stories with a wing and was widely known as the "old garrison" or the "Peasele Garrison House." The building is yet in a good state of repair, one of the landmarks of the Merrimac valley and of great interest to antiquarians. The house famed in prose and poetry was originally built by Dr. Peasele as a refuge for women and children from the Indians, and was used as a garrison house in the French and Indian and King Philip's wars. The first Quaker meetings in

that part of the country were held at this house, Dr. Peasele becoming a convert and joining the meeting. This was in 1699 after the town had refused them the use of the meeting house. In 1687 he was chosen constable, having taken the oath of fidelity and allegiance in 1677. In 1692 he was granted the privilege of erecting a sawmill. The mill was built the next year and for one hundred and fifty years thereafter was owned wholly or in part in the Peasele name. He was a large landowner, by grants, inheritance and purchase. He was noted as a physician, and selectman of Haverhill, 1689-90 and 1696, and in 1721 was again chosen constable. There is no record of his burial place.

He married (first), January 21, 1671, Ruth, born October 16, 1651, died November 5, 1733, daughter of Thomas and Eleanor M. Barnard. Her father, one of the first settlers of Amesbury, was killed by the Indians in 1677. Dr. Peasele married (second) Widow Mary (Tucker) Davis, daughter of Morris and Elizabeth (Gill) Tucker, and widow of Stephen Davis. Children of first wife: 1. Mary, born July 14, 1672; married, May 24, 1694, Joseph Whittier, youngest son of Thomas and Ruth (Green) Whittier. Joseph and Mary are the great-grandparents of John Greenleaf Whittier, the poet. 2. Joseph, born July 19, 1674; married Elizabeth Hastings, and settled in Salem, New Hampshire. 3. Robert, born February 3, 1677; married (first) Alice Carrier; (second) Ann Sargeant. He lived on the old homestead and was prominent in church and town. 4. John, of further mention. 5. Nathaniel, born June 25, 1682. He and Robert Peasele were members of the famous "land syndicate" of four hundred members, whose transactions and lawsuits would fill many volumes; was for nine years a representative in the Massachusetts house of assembly and for many years held the highest office in the town of Haverhill. He married (first) Judith Kimball; (second) Mrs. Abraham Swan; (third) Mrs. Martha Hutchins. 6. Ruth, born February 25, 1684. 7. Ebenezer, died young. 8. Sarah, born August 15, 1690.

(III) John, fourth child and third son of Dr. Joseph (2) and Ruth (Barnard) Peasele, was born in Haverhill, Massachusetts, February 25, 1679, died in Newton, New Hampshire, in 1752. He moved from Haverhill to Newton, New Hampshire, about 1715, settling in the southern part of the town. The

## ESTATE OF EDWARD HOLYOKE OF LYNN.

"The will of mee Edward Holyoke made the xxv. of December 1658. As for the holy faith of the holy one God in Trinitie: & of the holy faith of our glorious Lord the son of God the Lord Jesus Christ the Second Adam I haue composed a booke and do bestowe vpon each of my sonn in Law a booke as their best legacy beeseeching the heauenly father to instruct them & my daughters chiefly in the holy scriptures & vsing that help as a means fro the Lord to vnderstand the scriptures, & the Lord God by his good Spirit blesse the holy scriptures, & this helpe of their ffather & the publike ministry & any sound bookes of instruction ||and I doubt not see that my booke will giue them an hint of all sound doctrine: and an hint of all false & vnworthy doctrine.|| & it is my hearty desire|| & prayer to God|| that my children & childrens children may delight in the public assemblies of the saints & religiously observe the B. Lords day the ch[r]istian Sabbath: & loue priuate and publique prayer yea and secret prayer every day & loue godly ch[r]istians & delight only in them & that they be not drawn aside by the pleasures or profits & the vaine & froths company of this euill world wch lyes in all wickednesse. And I intreat my children that they bring vp their children wch they haue borne to God in the knowledg of God & of our Lord Jesus Christ The Lord Grant these things to his poore vnworthy servant that I may haue comfort that although I must be taken out of this world & go to the generation of the godly Patriarcks pphets Apossles & all the godly yet that I haue left among my children & childrens children the holy faith of the son of God for the hope of the life wch is eternall.

"As touching my worldly estate thus I dispose: a yoke of Oxen & my mare I bequeath to my sonn in Law Georg Keysar: my mare foale & a kow to my Son Pickman: 2 a kow to my son Andrewes: a kow to my daughter martyn. These oxen & kine are in the hands of goodman Wilkins of Lynn: the mare & foale is att Romney Marsh: I giue to my son Tuttell that 14<sup>th</sup> that yearly he should haue giuen mee since I putt ouer the howse at Boston to him: I never yet had peny of it: 40<sup>s</sup> I gaue him of it: so there is 6<sup>th</sup> yet behinde: & there is fife pounds mentioned in goodman wilkins lease that he owes me: 50<sup>s</sup> of it I giue to my daughter martyn: & Twenty shillings to my kinswoman Mary Mansfield. & x<sup>s</sup> of it to John Dolittle and x<sup>s</sup> of it to my kinsman Thomas Morris of new haven. & x<sup>s</sup> of it to Hannah Keysar. As touching my Apparell: I giue my best Cloake of that cloth that came fro England to my sonne Holyoke: as also my Coate of the same cloth. I giue my other cloke to my sonn Keyser: my best doublet and breeches to my son Tuttell: my stuff doublet ||and my best Hatt|| to my son Holyoke: & all the rest of my wearing apparell to my son keysar.

"As touching the wholl yeeres rent of this yeere 1658. that is due to me from goodman Wilkins of Lyn. I owe Theodore Atkins 49<sup>s</sup> pay him in wheate: I ow John Hull about 22<sup>s</sup> pay him in wheate pay m<sup>r</sup> Russell treasurer 3 bushell of wheate for John Andreues: viii bushell of wheate to m<sup>r</sup> Wilson Pastor at Boston: & 8 bushell of Indian. as for my linnen let all my daughters pt alike: The xx<sup>s</sup> goodman Page oweth mee as my son Tuttell can witnesse I giue my Daughter Martyn: There is about xv<sup>s</sup> Captaine Saugie oweth mee: intreat him to satisfie my Cousin Davis & the rest giue to my Daughter martyn As for my bookes & writings: I giue my son Holyoke all the bookes that are at Lynn: as also the yron chest. And the bookes I haue in my study that are m<sup>r</sup> Broughtons works I giue him: he only can make vse of them: & like wise I giue him all my manuscripts whatsoever: & I ||giue|| him that large new Testam<sup>t</sup> in folio w<sup>th</sup> wast pap betweene euery leafe that I giue him. As also mr Ainsworth on the 5. bookes of Moses & the psalms: & my Dictionary & Tremollins Bible in latin: & my Latin coment[ary on] Daniel bound together: these I giue to my son Holyoke. & a pt of the N Testam<sup>t</sup>: in folio w<sup>th</sup> wast pap betweene euery leafe: & the great mapps of genealogy & that old manuscript called a *synassight*. the rest for a musket I gaue of old to my son Holyoke. All my land in Lyn & that land & meadow in the contrey neere Reading all was giuen to my son Holyoke when he married m<sup>r</sup> Pynchons daughter."

M<sup>r</sup> Elizur Holioko only son of Edward Holyoke appointed June 25, 1660, administrator to his father's imperfect will.

Vtensills belonging to ye farme, 10li.; a parcell of land at Nahant about 3 acres, 6li.; A farme at Bever Damme neere Readinge, 150li.; Bookes at lynne & Rumney Marsh, 20li.; Wearinge cloths, 10li., a deske 5s. 10li. 5s.; An iron chest & other chests, 40s., 2 bedsteads, 20s., 3li.; a rest for a muskett, 5s., a little lynnene, 20s., 1li. 5s.; Debts about 19li.; total, 681li. According to our apprehensions of the Estate we judge these to be indifferent prizes thereof.

Some bookes excepted lent out & not Gott in & the two farmes formerly on marriage Cuvent to ye sd. Elizur Holyoke.

Elizur Holioko deposed June 25, 1660, this to be a true inventory of his late father's Estate to y<sup>e</sup> best of his knowledge & y<sup>t</sup> when he knew more he will discover it.

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Mary Sherman, who was born in New Brunswick, Canada, August 2, 1860, and removed with her parents to Aroostook county when she was three years old. She is a daughter of Caleb Sherman, a native of New Brunswick, farmer and lumberman, who died at Oakfield, Maine, in 1904. Children of Caleb Sherman: 1. Susan, married Charles Berry, of Houlton, a merchant; she resides at Island Falls. 2. Joseph, died at Masardis, Maine; was a miner in the west and afterward a farmer in Masardis. 3. William, twin of Joseph, resides at Island Falls, a lumberman. 4. Anna, died at Oakfield; married William Collis, a saw mill owner of Oakfield. 5. Lavinia, died at Masardis; married Abon Weeks, of Patten, Maine, lumberman. 6. Elizabeth, married William Harper, carpenter and farmer of Smyrna, Maine. 7. Ambrose, resides in Oakfield; married (second) Adra Thompson. 8. Fred, resides at Island Falls, a farmer and merchant. 9. Mary, married William W. Sewall, mentioned above. 10. Walter, married Amy Stevens, of Smyrna. Children of William Wingate Sewall: 1. Lucretia, born April 28, 1884; married Thomas Tracy, of Amity, Maine; clerk in the grange store at Island Falls. 2. Fred Stinson, mentioned below. 3. Harriet, born August 6, 1888; married George Harmon, of Island Falls, now of Warner, New Hampshire, principal of the high school; children: Harriet, born 1910; Donald, March 4, 1913. 4. Merrill, born July 17, 1891; married Myrtle Trafton, of Island Falls, in charge of his brother's camps at Mattawamkeag Lake. 5. Nancy, born October 7, 1894, student in the high school.

(XI) Fred Stinson Sewall, son of William Wingate Sewall, was born at Elk Horn, North Dakota, August 5, 1886. He attended the public schools of Island Falls, leaving the high school in 1903 to work in the woods. Since then he has been lumbering and assisting his father on the homestead. In partnership with his father he has lumber camps on Mattawamkeag Lake. In politics he is a Progressive, formerly a Republican. In religion he is a Congregationalist. He is a member of the Island Falls Lodge of Free Masons, and of Daniel Randall Chapter, Royal Arch Masons.

He married, June 20, 1912, at Harrisburg, Pennsylvania, Phillis G. Garverich, who was born at Dauphin, Pennsylvania, daughter of Dr. Frank Garverich, of Harrisburg, and Margaret (Steese) Garverich. Children of Dr. Garverich: 1. Phillis G., mentioned above. 2. Susan, born 1883. 3. Mary, born 1889, stenographer. 4. Elizabeth, born February, 1893. Augustus Garverich, father of Dr. Frank Garverich, was born in Pennsylvania in 1827, a

retired merchant, living at Dauphin. Mr. and Mrs. Sewall have one child, Clara Elizabeth, born at Island Falls, July 24, 1913.

Isaac Buzzell or Buswell, the BUZZELL immigrant ancestor of most of the New Hampshire, Maine and Massachusetts families of this surname, was born in England about 1593. He was in Salisbury, Massachusetts, and one of its proprietors in 1639. He was admitted a freeman, October 9, 1640. He drew land in the first division at Salisbury, and again in 1640. The general court allowed his removal to Hampton in 1639, but he returned to Salisbury. His wife Marguerite died September 29, 1642, and he married (second) Susanna ———, who died March 21, 1676-77. He died July 8, 1683. His will was dated April 9, 1680. He bequeathed to son William and his wife; daughter Sarah; son-in-law, John Gill, husband of daughter Phebe; Philip Browne, husband of daughter Mary, and son, Samuel Buzzell; to the three children left by his son Isaac, and to grandchild Isaac, son of William. Children: William; Sarah; Phebe, married John Gill; Samuel, mentioned below; Mary, born August 29, 1645, married Philip Brown; Isaac, born July 24, 1650.

(II) Samuel Buzzell, son of Isaac Buzzell, was born about 1628, in England. He was a planter in Salisbury and Bradford, Massachusetts. He was of Salisbury in 1662 and probably 1669, but of Andover in 1696 and in Boxford at the time of his death. Savage says he may have been at Marblehead for a short time in 1668. His will, dated April 9, 1704, was proved July 27, 1704, naming his wife Sarah executrix, and his brother-in-law, Solomon Keyes, of Chelmsford, and John Boynton, of Boxford, overseers. Children: Isaac, born August 6, 1657; John, mentioned below; Samuel, born May 25, 1662, probably died before his father; William, born August 5, 1664; Robert, born February 6, 1666-67; James, born March 30, 1668-69; Mary; Joseph, married Mary Harvey.

(III) John Buzzell, son of Samuel Buzzell, was born October 7, 1659. He resided at Boxford from about 1700 to 1707, perhaps longer. The death of a John Buzzell is recorded at Boxford, February 22, 1750-51. Family tradition has it that he was from the Isle of Jersey, meaning doubtless his father. It seems probable that all the Buzzells of this vicinity were related closely, but the spelling of the name was so varied as to bewilder the investigator. Many of the settlers of Marblehead and the towns of that vicinity were from Jersey, Guernsey and seaports of England, with many

Copy of the will of James (his mark) Davis, sr., of Haverhill, dated Mar. 17, 1675-6, brought into Salisbury court, Oct. 14, 1679: "knowing assuredly y<sup>t</sup> all men are mortall, & y<sup>t</sup> young men may die suddenly & old men must die & how suddenly my owne time maybee in these desolating times wherein y<sup>e</sup> enemy seeks y<sup>e</sup> destruction of our New England Israell . . . I giue to my sone John Davis all my third division of land in Haverhill w<sup>th</sup> all y<sup>e</sup> additions belonging to it according to y<sup>e</sup> grant of y<sup>e</sup> towne of Haverhill together w<sup>th</sup> my third division of meadow in haverhill. I giue unto James Davis y<sup>e</sup> sone of my sone John Davis y<sup>e</sup> one halfe of my forth division, or y<sup>e</sup> full right to y<sup>e</sup> one halfe of my forth division of upland in Haverhill, it beeing not yet layd out I giue to my sone Ephraim Davis all y<sup>t</sup> land being thirty acres more or less w<sup>e</sup> hee hath built upon joyning to y<sup>e</sup> great playne in Haverhill I giue him also y<sup>t</sup> halfe of my East meadow w<sup>e</sup> I made use of for my selfe, I give him also all y<sup>e</sup> sheep and other cattle w<sup>e</sup> hee hath of mine in his hands. I giue to Steven & Ephraim Davis y<sup>e</sup> sonns of my sone Ephraim Davis y<sup>e</sup> other half of my fourth division upland to bee equally divided between them when it is layd out my son John Davis his sone James or his Agent, being to haue his first choyce of his halfe I giue to my sone Ephraim Davis two oxe commons & also fiue cow commons. I giue to my sone Samll. Davis my second division of upland & one oxe common & also three cow common & all in Haverhill. I giue to my daughter Sarah the wyfe of John Page Jun<sup>r</sup> y<sup>e</sup> one halfe of my pond meadow & also y<sup>e</sup> goods of mine w<sup>e</sup> her husband hath in his possession excepting only my warming pan. I giue to James Gild y<sup>e</sup> sone of Sam<sup>l</sup> Gild y<sup>e</sup> one halfe of my pond meadow, my daughter Sarah or one in her behalfe being to haue the first choyce;" son James, executor, to whom he left all his other estate. Wit: Nath. Saltonstall, and James (his mark) Swaddocke. A codicil, dated July 22, 1678, revokes the words "to Jn<sup>o</sup> Page jun. three cow commons," and appoints William White and Nath. ter of Arts. He graduated in 1866 from the law school of Columbia University, with the degree of Bachelor of Laws. In the meantime he had served, by appointment, upon the provost-marshal's staff, in connection with drafting and recruiting for the army, and at the close of the civil war was acting provost-marshal in New York. After admission to the bar he became assistant United States district attorney for the eastern district of New York, and filled this position for seven years, when he resigned to engage in general law practice. In the fall of 1873 he received the unanimous nomination for the New York state assembly, and was one of the two Republicans elected from Brooklyn in that year, leading his ticket by a large vote. From 1874, for several years, he held the position of United States chief supervisor of elections for the eastern district of the state of New York. He was also for many years a United States commissioner and master in chancery, United States courts. His law practice has been extensive, largely in the United States courts of New York and Brooklyn, and latterly as counsel to corporations. Among others, he is a member of the Society of Colonial Wars; New England Society; New York Champlain Association; Brooklyn Society of Arts and Sciences; Phi Beta Kappa Alumni, New York; Ethan Allen Club, Vermont; president of Sigma Phi fraternity, New York; was president of Brooklyn Republican Club; member of Union League; president of New York Alumni Association, University of Vermont. His summer home is at Burlington, Vermont, the location for more than a century of the family homestead of his maternal grandfather, Hon. **Johnson**, for many years surveyor-general of Vermont.

He married, June 30, 1870, Louisa A., daughter of Judge Charles Shaler, of the supreme court of Pennsylvania, and Mary Ann Riddle. They have three children, all born in Brooklyn, New York, and unmarried: 1. Marion Shaler, born July 7, 1874 (Bachelor of Arts, University of Vermont, 1895; Bachelor of Laws, New York Law School, 1897); admitted to the bar, February, 1898; practices in Brooklyn, New York. 2. Elizabeth, born March 17, 1877 (Bachelor of Arts and Master of Arts, Barnard College, Columbia University); resides in Brooklyn, New York. 3. Marguerite Louisa, born April 14, 1884; resides in Brooklyn, New York.

There were many immigrants of this name among the pioneer settlers of Massachusetts, and among these were brothers—Edward, **John**, and probably Stephen. There were also

two of the name—**John** and Robert—very early at New Haven, Connecticut. All have left a progeny distinguished for the energy, ability and moral uprightness which were general features of the New England character.

(I) **John Johnson** was born at Waterham, in the parish of Herne-Hill, near Canterbury, Kent county, England, and came with his relatives to America, probably in 1630. He is first mentioned on the records as among the "earliest settlers" of Ipswich, Massachusetts, in 1635, and was one of its proprietors at that time, as shown by deed given by his son Thomas in 1715. The early records of Ipswich are fragmentary, and the earliest records of **Andover**, Massachusetts, whither he removed, have been lost, and it is impossible to establish many facts concerning the family. He was one of the proprietors of **Andover** in 1657, and took the oath of allegiance, February 11, 1678. His wife **Susanna** died in **Andover**, September 12, 1683, and he did not long survive her.

(II) Timothy, son of **John** and **Susanna Johnson**, was born about 1644, and removed with his father to **Andover**, where he lived, and died March 15, 1688. In 1676 he was constable of the town. He married, in **Andover**, December 15, 1674, Rebecca Aslett, born May 6, 1652, daughter of **John** and Rebecca Aslett. Their children were: **John**, born June 29, 1677, died June 3, 1761; Timothy, mentioned below; Mary, born February 3, 1682, married Abraham Foster; Samuel, born July 25, 1684, died in Philadelphia, Pennsylvania; Peter, born January 31, 1686; Mercy, born November 18, 1687.

(III) Timothy (2), second son of Timothy (1) and Rebecca (Aslett) **Johnson**, was born March 25, 1679, in **Andover**, and died there in 1771, aged ninety-two years. (The house in which he was born, in **Andover**, was standing in 1833). He was nine years a selectman of the town, and three years a representative at the general court. He was captain of troops in the French and Indian war, and his son Timothy died at Louisburg, December 16, 1746. Timothy (2) **Johnson** married, April 3, 1705, in **Andover**, Catherine Sprague, born 1682, died February 22, 1758. The records of the town have been so worn that the names of all his children cannot be distinguished. Those recorded are: Timothy, born February 21, 1706, died February 14, 1707; a child, born March 27, 1711; Samuel, born March 23, 1713, died November 12, 1796; Martha, born January 16, 1715, died May 8, 1715; Asa, mentioned below; Timothy, born December 27, 1717, died in the king's service at Louisburg, Cape Breton Island, December 16, 1746;

## DAVIS FAMILY.

HAVERHILL, MASS.

## I.

**James' Davis**, the pioneer of this branch of the Davis family was probably born in Marlborough, Wiltshire County, England, about 1583-8. He came to this country with his wife and three sons and settled first at Newbury, Mass. He with twelve others, under the lead of Rev. John Ward, secured a grant from the government and settled what is now Haverhill; they went there in 1640. Samuel Gile, who seven years later became his son-in-law, was among the twelve. They went about clearing the woods off and making a settlement. In 1642 they bought out the rights of the Indians to the land, and Thomas Davis, a brother of James, was one of the witnesses to the deed. This Thomas was a sawyer and came from Marlborough, England, soon after James did. James must have been a man of considerable wealth for those times, for in 1643 he was one of three in the settlement that were worth over £200, and in 1646 James Davis paid the largest tax. When the town elected its first selectmen in 1646 they were: James Davis, Thomas Davis, Thomas Hale, Henry Palmer and William White. In 1645 there were thirty-two land-holders in the town, and James Davis, James

NOTE. James Davis Sr. and his son Ephraim signed a paper presented to Ipswich Court, February, 1658, against John Godfrey, accusing him of witchcraft.

NOTE. In 1650 a law was passed that forbid any person whose estate did not exceed £200 from wearing any gold or silver lace or buttons, silk hoods, ribbons or scarfs, under penalty of 10 shillings.

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## WARDEN FAMILY GENEALOGY.

Davis Jr. and John Davis were among them; also John Eaton and Joseph Peasley, whose daughters married James Jr. and John Davis. The first meeting house was built in 1646, and "Thomas Davis was given £3 to ground-pin and daub it. He to provide the stone and clay." In the second division of land, made in 1652, James Davis had 10 acres, James Davis Jr. 10 acres, John Davis 6 acres, Thomas Davis 8 acres, John Eaton 10 acres.

His wife was Cicely or Sissilla ———. His wife and three of the children must have come over with him, for James, John and Judith were born before his arrival in this country. He died 29 Jan., 1678-9, and left a will which was proven in in 1680. His wife died 28 May, 1673, at Haverhill.

Six children were born to this couple:

- 2 i. **James<sup>2</sup> Davis**, born in Marlborough, England, died in Haverhill 1694.
- 3 ii. **John<sup>2</sup> Davis**, born in Marlborough, England, 1623, died in 1685.
- 4 iii. **Judith<sup>2</sup> Davis**, born in Marlborough, England, married in 1647 to Samuel Gile of Haverhill; he came to America in the "Ann," in 1636, settled in Dedham, then Haverhill.
- 5 iv. **Ephraim<sup>2</sup> Davis**, born —, married Mary Johnson of Andover, 31 Dec., 1659.
- 6 v. **Samuel<sup>2</sup> Davis**, born —, married Deborah Barnes of Haverhill in December, 1663.
- 7 vi. **Sarah<sup>2</sup> Davis**, born —, married John Page of Haverhill, son of John and Mary (Marsh) Page, 18 June, 1663.
